AN ACT

To incorporate the Farmers' and Mechanics' Mutual Insurance association of Bucks county.

Managers **SECTION 1.** *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That William Kitchen, Robert Smith, Isaac C. Kirk, James M. M'Nair, Ely Fell, Samuel Beans, Benjamin S. Rich, and their associates, successors and assigns, be, and they are hereby created and constituted a body corporate, by the name, style and title of "the Farmers' and Mechanics' Mutual Insurance association of Bucks county," and shall have all the rights and privileges, and be subject to the same provisions as the act, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Independent Mutual Fire Insurance company of Bucks, Montgomery and Philadelphia counties," passed the tenth day of February, one thousand eight hundred and forty-three, and said corporation shall confine its operation to the county of Bucks. The first seven named persons in this bill shall constitute the first board of managers, to carry this act into effect. This act shall continue in force for the term of twenty years, and no longer.
