AN ACT

To incorporate the Farmers' Mutual Fire Insurance Society of Warminster, in Bucks county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That Samuel Shoemaker, Daniel Longstreth, Jacob Fretz, Joseph Hart, Seth Tyson, Joseph Carr, Isaac Twining, John Lloyd, James Horner, Seth Davis and Silas Twining, their associates, successors and assigns, be, and are hereby created and constituted a body corporate in law, by the name, style and title of "the Farmers' Mutual Fire Insurance society of Warminster, Bucks county," against loss sustained by fire, with all the legal incidents of a corporation, and shall have all the rights and privileges, and shall be subject to the same provisions conferred by the act, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Independent Mutual Fire Insurance company of Bucks, Montgomery and Philadelphia counties," passed the tenth day of February, eighteen hundred and forty-three. This corporation shall confine its operations within the limits of Bucks and Montgomery counties, and shall continue in force for the term of twenty years, and no longer.
