AN ACT

Extending the time for the completion of the Lock Navigation on the river Monongahela, and for other purposes.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the time fixed for the completion of the lock navigation on the Monongahela river, by the seventeenth section of the act, entitled "An Act to authorize the governor to incorporate a company to make a lock navigation on the river Monongahela," passed on the thirty-first day of March, eighteen hundred and thirty-six, be and the same is hereby extended for another period of seven years, from the passage of this act.

SECTION 2. The time for commencing the Hamburg, Allentown, Bethlehem and Easton railroad, be and the same is hereby extended to three years, and the time for completing the said road to eight, from and after the passage of this act.
