AN ACT

To authorize the Marion Hose Company, in the county of Philadelphia, to purchase and hold real estate.

Powers

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That "the Marion Hose company of Philadelphia," shall be able and capable to purchase, take, receive, have, hold and enjoy, to them and their successors, lands, messages, tenements, rents, annuities and hereditaments, goods and chattels in common with, and in addition to all and every the real and personal estate now held by or in possession of the said company, or that the said company is entitled to by purchase, gift, grant or devise; and the said real and personal estate, or any part thereof, at their option, from time to time to sell, grant, mortgage, alien or dispose of: *Provided,* That the yearly value or income of the real and personal estate of the said company, now held by them, or that may hereafter be held by them, shall not exceed two thousand dollars.
