A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT

To an act, entitled "An Act authorizing the Governor to incorporate a company to make an artificial road, commencing where the Schuylkill canal road intersects the Ridge turnpike road, near Robeson's mill, thence along the bed of said road to the Flat Rock bridge," passed April tenth, eighteen hundred and twenty-six.

Termination SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the present managers and company of the Manayunk and Flat Rock turnpike road be and they are hereby exonerated from any obligation, further to complete the said road beyond its present termination, at the bridge across the canal at Rowland's mill; and so much of an act authorizing the governor to incorporate the said company, and of the supplements thereto, as is inconsistent herewith, be and the same is hereby repealed: *Provided*, That the town council of the borough of Manayunk shall have the privilege, under the direction of the president and managers of said turnpike company, of paving or macadamizing two and a half feet on each side of said road, now used as ditches: *And provided further*, That said road shall not be less than forty-five feet wide.
