AN ACT

Authorizing the Canal Commissioners to settle the damages alleged by
John Evans.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the canal commissioners are hereby authorized and empowered to examine into the alleged damage sustained by John Evans, of Columbia, Lancaster county, by reason of the construction of the Pennsylvania railroad avoiding the inclined plane there, and to settle the same on just and equitable terms; and if any thing shall be found due to him, he shall be entitled to a credit for the amount on the books of the auditor general, bearing interest at six per cent. per annum from the date of the entry.
