A N A C T

To incorporate the Frankford Mutual Insurance company of the county of Philadelphia.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That Isaac Whitelock, Henry Taylor, William Kinsey, William Overington, Ezra Shallcross, Samuel Pilling, John F. Lamb, George F. Womrath, Peter Castor, Levi P. Coats, William Borger, William Hilles, Isaac Shallcross, Lewis Emery, James Sedden, William McCormick, Robert B. Griffith, Charles E. Deal, George Sheets, Abraham Abraham, Robert Burns, Robert Thornton, Thomas Castor, George W. Deal, John G. Tees, Isaacher Pugh, John Stull, Isaac C. Worrell, Robert C. Martin, Henry Eberle, Robert Shaw, Henry R. Shoch, Benjamin F. Deal, John Newcamp, James D. Pratt, and all other persons being citizens of the United States, who may hereafter associate with them in the manner hereinafter prescribed, shall be a corporation by the name of the Frankford Mutual Fire Insurance company of the county of Philadelphia, and shall have all the rights and privileges of the act, entitled "An Act to incorporate the mutual fire insurance company of Bucks, Montgomery and Philadelphia counties, passed the tenth day of February, one thousand eight hundred and forty-three;" and the first thirteen named persons in this act, shall constitute the first board of managers to carry this act into effect. The acts of this incorporation shall be confined to the counties of Bucks, Montgomery and Philadelphia. This act shall continue in force for the term of twenty years and no longer.
