AN ACT

To legalize certain acts of the Commissioners of Warren county.

Preamble

WHEREAS, the commissioners of Warren county have made certain improvements in, about and upon the public buildings, and have expended considerable sums of money in the performance of what they conceived to be their legitimate duties : *And whereas*, It does not appear by the records of said county that said improvements and expenditures were recommended by two grand juries ; for remedy whereof,

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That if a majority of a future grand jury shall report that said improvements and expenditures were necessary and proper, and the court of common pleas of said county shall approve and confirm said report, then the said improvements and expenditures and all acts of the commissioners in relation thereto shall be and are hereby declared legal and valid.
