AN ACT

Awarding to John D. Miles, Judge Advocate of a Court Martial, lately held in the county of Philadelphia, certain compensation, and for other purposes.

Preamble

WHEREAS, There is no provision made by the laws of this commonwealth for the payment of judge advocates of courts martial: *And whereas*, John D. Miles acted in the capacity of judge advocate of a court martial assembled in the county of Philadelphia for the trial of Major Rudolph H. Bartle, brigade inspector of the second brigade, first division, Pennsylvania militia, and owing to the deficiency of the laws above mentioned cannot without special provision of the legislature receive a compensation for his services: *And whereas*, It has heretofore been the practice of this legislature to make such special provision aforesaid; therefore,

Compensation to J D Miles

Resolved by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby resolved by the authority of the same, That the state treasurer be and he is hereby authorized to pay out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, to the said John D. Miles, one hundred and fifty dollars for his services as judge advocate at the court martial as aforesaid, and to charge the same to the account of the brigade inspector of the second brigade, first division, Pennsylvania militia.

Compensation to J W Evans

Resolved, That the state treasurer be and he is hereby authorized to pay out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, to J. W. Evans, judge advocate of the court martial appointed for the trial of Captain A. Eddy, and Lieutenants Henry S. Hitner and Charles Freas, convened on the sixteenth day of January, one thousand eight hundred and forty-three, eighty-two dollars and seventy-five cents, for his services and expenses as judge advocate as aforesaid, and to charge the same to the account of the brigade inspector of the second brigade, second division, Pennsylvania militia.
