AN ACT

To incorporate the Mutual Fire Insurance company of Sinking Springs,
of Berks county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That Samuel Addams, William Spahn, Corporators William Palm, Thomas H. Jones, Benjamin Hain, son of Joseph Hain, Michael Selser, Nicholas Yocum, John Gerant, (Maiden Creek,) Charles Van Reed, Adam Leis, John Potteiger, Joseph Smucker and Aaron Mull, and such other persons as may associate with them, under the authority of this act, their successors or assigns are hereby made a corporation by the name and style of the Mutual fire insurance company of the Sinking Springs, Berks county, with all the rights and privileges conferred by the act entitled "An Act to incorporate the Independent Mutual Fire Insurance company of Bucks, Montgomery and Philadelphia counties," passed tenth February, one thousand eight hundred and forty-three. The first thirteen named persons in this act shall constitute the first board of managers to carry this act into effect; this act shall continue in force for the term of twenty years and no longer.
