AN ACT

To incorporate the Southern Mutual Fire Insurance company of York county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That George S. Murphy, Joseph D. Wiley, James L. M'Call, John R. Donnell, Adam Ebaugh, Andrew M'Konkey, Henry M'Konkey, Robert Ramsey, John Wisler, Samuel Brannon, James Cameron, Samuel M. Wright, Ebenezer Wilson, John M. Anderson, John Neeper, and all other persons citizens of the United States, who may hereafter associate with them in the manner hereafter prescribed, shall be and they are hereby constituted and declared to be a body politic and corporate, by the style and title of the "Southern Mutual Fire Insurance company of York county;" and shall have all the rights and privileges, and shall be subject to the same provisions as the act, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Independent Mutual Fire Insurance company of Bucks, Montgomery and Philadelphia counties," passed the tenth day of February, one thousand eight hundred and forty-three. The first thirteen named persons in this act shall constitute the first board of managers to carry this act into effect. This act shall continue in force for the term of twenty years and no longer. This corporation shall confine its operations to the county of York and adjoining counties.

SECTION 2. This act shall not go into effect until the amount of fifty thousand dollars shall be subscribed.
