

eight hundred and forty-one, entitled "An Act to provide revenue to meet the demands on the treasury, and for other purposes," and the auditor general and state treasurer are authorized to issue certificates therefor, to such persons and for such amounts as the said directors shall designate, upon the same conditions as to time of payment and rate of interest, as the said loans are held by said bank.

SECTION 3. That no reduction be made in the capital stock as aforesaid, until a majority of the stockholders (at a meeting called for the purpose) shall assent thereto. Reduction

SECTION 4. That after the transfer of said debt or loans, the said bank shall be exempt from the payment of interest on any part thereof, as provided by the fifth section of the act of May fourth, one thousand eight hundred and forty-one, above recited. Interest on

A N A C T

Supplementary to an act incorporating the borough of Schuylkill Haven, in the county of Schuylkill.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the following shall be the boundaries of said borough, instead of the description contained in the act incorporating said borough, viz: Beginning at the state road leading to Harrisburg, at the point where the state road Borough
boundaries

leading to Røhrersburg intersects the same; thence north fifteen degrees west two hundred and twenty-four perches to a poplar near the west bank of the river Schuylkill; thence along and over the said river and over the Schuylkill canal north seven degrees east ninety-seven perches to a white walnut on the side of the road, leading from the Centre turnpike to John Pott's mill; thence along said road and crossing the Centre turnpike north sixty-nine degrees east fifty-six perches to a corner in Henry Enis' land north of the East Schuylkill Haven Hotel; thence still through Henry Enis' land and on the line of the lots fronting the turnpike in the eastern addition to Schuylkill Haven south seventy-nine degrees east one hundred and ten perches to the line of the Schuylkill county almshouse farm, and in the Centre turnpike; thence along the line of said farm and the widow Heiser's lot south fourteen degrees east one hundred and sixty-one perches to an alley or street in the original town plot; thence along the same south forty-one degrees west eighteen perches to another street; thence along the same south forty-nine degrees east thirty-four perches; thence along the lines of Abraham Boyer's farm south forty-one degrees west thirty-one perches, south forty-nine degrees east thirty-two perches, north forty-one degrees east twenty-three perches, south twenty degrees east twenty-six perches, south eighty degrees west ten perches, south forty-one degrees west ten perches, south forty-nine degrees east eighteen perches, south eighty-three degrees west twenty-four perches, south forty-one degrees west fourteen perches, south forty-nine degrees east forty perches, south sixty degrees west twenty-four perches, north forty-nine degrees west thirty-six perches, south forty-one degrees west thirty-two perches, south forty-nine degrees east twenty perches, and south twenty-three degrees west seventy-three perches to the river Schuylkill; thence along the same north eighty-seven degrees west thirty perches, north fifty-six degrees west fourteen perches, north forty-four degrees west sixty-eight perches; thence crossing said river north twenty-eight degrees west thirty-two perches, to the place of beginning.
