AN ACT

To incorporate the Perry County Mutual Fire Insurance company.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same;* That Finlow M'Cowen, David Darlington, John Gatwalt, John Witherow, David Deardorff, John Rice, John M'Bride, David Laper, Joseph Casey, James Black, Samuel Leiley, John Junkin, Henry Fetter, William B. Anderson, Abram Addams, Thomas Cochran, Robert Elliot, Abram B. Demarce, Jacob Evinger, Jacob Shearer; and all other persons who may hereafter associate with them in the manner herein prescribed, shall be a corporation by the name of the "Perry County Mutual Fire Insurance company;" and shall have all the rights and privileges, and shall be subject to the same provisions as the act, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Independent Mutual Fire Insurance company of Bucks, Montgomery and Philadelphia counties," passed the tenth day of February, one thousand eight hundred and forty-three; the first thirteen named persons in this act shall constitute the first board of managers to carry this act into effect. This corporation shall confine its operations to the county of Perry. This act shall not go into effect until fifty thousand dollars is subscribed. This act shall continue in force for the term of twenty years and no longer.
