## AN ACT

Relative to supervisors in the township of Augusta, in the county of Northumberland, and for other purposes.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That it shall hereafter be lawful for the qualified voters of Augusta township, in the county of Northumberland, annually, to elect three supervisors of roads for said township at the time and place now fixed by law for the election of supervisors; and the election of three supervisors which took place in said township on the seventeenth day of March, instant, is hereby declared good and valid, to all intents and purposes, as if the same had been held and conducted in pursuance of law.

SECTION 2. That the act supplementary to an act granting certain powers to the authorities of the cities of Lancaster and Philadelphia, and for other purposes, passed the sixteenth day of April, Anno Domini, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-nine, and extended to the county of Chester, the twenty-seventh day of March, Anno Domini, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-nine, relating to letting out the public roads by contract by the supervisors of the several townships in the county of Chester, be and the same is hereby repealed, so far as relates to the townships of Honeybrook, Newlin, East Marlborough and West Bradford, in said county.

SECTION 3. That the borough of Lawrenceville, in the county of Allegheny, be and the same is hereby authorized and empowered to institute legal proceedings, by ejectment or otherwise, for the purpose of settling and establishing the lines of the lots, streets and alleys, within the said borough of Lawrenceville; and that the same powers be granted to said borough that are possessed by individuals, when the question of title or boundary arises.

## AN ACT

Supplementary to an act, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Reliance Insurance and Trust company of Philadelphia."

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the name, style and title of "The Reliance Insurance and Trust company of Philadelphia," authorized by an act, approved the twenty-first day of April, eighteen hundred and forty-one, shall be and the same is hereby changed to that of "The Reliance Mutual Insurance company of Philadelphia;" and by that name, style and title shall have and enjoy the rights and privileges, and be subject to the restrictions and penalties in said act mentioned, except as hereinafter provided; and the capital stock of said company shall be reduced to one hundred and fifty thousand dollars, to be divided into shares of fifty dollars each, and to be subscribed and paid in according to the provisions of the act to which this is a supplement.

SECTION 2. All persons who shall ensure with the said company, and pay or secure to be paid, the premium on the
