AN ACT

To annul the marriage contract of Anna Maria Kraft and Lewis Kraft.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the marriage contract entered into between Anna Maria Kraft and Lewis Kraft, of the county of Cumberland, and commonwealth of Pennsylvania, be and the same is hereby annulled and made void, and the parties released and discharged from the said contract, and from all legal duties and obligations arising therefrom, as fully, effectually and absolutely as if they had never been joined in marriage. And the word "citizen" used in the eleventh section of the act concerning divorcees, passed the thirteenth of March, eighteen hundred and fifteen, shall not be construed to apply to any woman who shall have had a bona fide residence in this state at least one whole year previous to filing her petition or libel.
