A RESOLUTION

To provide for the payment of the interest on the public debt, falling due on the first days of February and August, eighteen hundred and forty-three.

RESOLVED, By the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, That the governor be and he is hereby authorized and directed to cause certificates of stock, transferable on the books of the auditor general, to be issued to the persons respectively to whom the interest on the state debt became due on the first day of February, eighteen hundred and forty-three, and also on the first day of August next; to the persons respectively to whom interest shall then become due, which said certificates shall be signed by the auditor general, and countersigned

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by the state treasurer, and bear an interest of six per centum per annum, payable yearly, at such place as may be by him designated, and redeemable on the first day of August, eighteen hundred and forty-six: *Provided*, That in all cases where the amount of interest claimed does not exceed twenty dollars, the same shall be paid out of any money in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, if the certificate upon which such interest be demanded shall have been issued prior to the first day of February, eighteen hundred and forty-three.
