Repealing the act which prohibits the courts from granting tavern licenses to sheriffs, so far as respects Indiana county.

RESOLVED, *By the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met*, That the provisions of the forty-fourth section of the act, entitled "An Act to appoint commissioners to resurvey and mark that portion of the county line which divides the township of Bristol, in the county of Philadelphia, from the township of Cheltenham, in the county of Montgomery, and for other purposes," passed the twenty-fifth day of March, A. D. one thousand eight hundred and forty-two, shall not extend to the county of Indiana.
