## RESOLUTION

Relative to the adoption of the Common School System in Elk Lick township, Somerset county.

**Preamble** WHEREAS, The school directors of Elk Lick township, Somerset county, have neglected to hold a meeting on the day appointed by law for the purpose of adopting the common school system; therefore,

**School directors Somerset co Bucks co** **RESOLVED**, *By the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met*, That the school directors of Elk Lick township, Somerset county, and the school directors of New Britain township, Bucks county, be and are hereby authorized and required to call a meeting for the purpose of adopting or rejecting the common school system, on or before the first Monday of June next, provided the said school directors give public notice according to law.

**School directors Delaware co** **RESOLVED**, That the school directors of the township of Thornbury, in the county of Delaware, shall be and they are hereby required to call a meeting of the qualified voters of the district on the first Tuesday in May next, to be held at the usual place of holding township elections, at which time and place an election shall be held to decide by ballot whether the common school system shall be continued or not; which meeting shall be conducted in the manner pointed out in the twelfth section of the act of the twelfth April, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-eight.
