RESOLUTION

Repealing the second section of the act incorporating the Eagle Iron company, and for other purposes.

RESOLVED, By the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, That the second section of the act, entitled "An Act to incorporate the Eagle Iron company, and for other purposes," approved the fifth day of May, Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and forty-one, be and the same is hereby repealed.

RESOLVED, That so much of the act, entitled "A supplement to an act, entitled 'An Act to incorporate the Wyoming coal company,'" as requires the making of ten miles of railroad, five miles within five years, and the remainder within ten years, be and the same is hereby repealed. It shall be lawful for the said company to build the said ten miles of railroad under the provisions of the said act, as soon as the interests of the said company may require.
