RESOLUTION

In relation to the Brookville Academy.

RESOLVED, *By the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met*, That the twenty-second section of the act of the twenty-ninth day of May, eighteen hundred and forty-one, supplementary to the act of the thirteenth of April, eighteen hundred and thirty-eight, establishing an academy in the borough of Brookville, in the county of Jefferson, shall not be so construed as to allow the qualified voters of said county to vote for trustees of said academy, until the commissioners of said county shall have subscribed the sum of five hundred dollars, mentioned in said act; and that the trustees elected on the first Friday of August, eighteen hundred and forty-one, in pursuance of the second section of the act of the thirtieth of April, eighteen hundred and thirty-eight, incorporating said academy, are hereby declared to be the legal trustees of said academy until their successors be elected, and all that they have done, or may do, within the scope of their duties as trustees as aforesaid, are hereby declared to be obligatory on said institution.
