AN ACT

AN ACT

To open and extend Ann street, in the borough of Petersburg, in the county of Perry.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That* the town council of the borough of Petersburg, in the county of Perry, *Ann street.* are hereby authorized and required to lay out, open and extend Ann street, in said borough, so as to intersect the great road leading to Bloomfield, in said county.

SECTION 2. It shall be the duty of said town council aforesaid, or a majority of them, (first taking an oath or affirmation, before some justice of the peace, to perform the duties enjoined upon them by this act, with impartiality and fidelity,) to proceed as soon after the passage of this act as convenient, to attend to the duties specified in the preceding section of this act; and if in their opinion, or the opinion of a majority
