AN ACT

Authorizing the governor to incorporate the Indian Orchard and Lackawaxen turnpike road company.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That* Russell F. Lord, Thomas J. Ridgeway, Jacob Kimble, Ephraim Kimble, Mossep Bingham, David Bishop, Joseph Atkinson, Bulkley Beardsler, Zenas H. Russell, be and they are hereby appointed commissioners to open books, receive subscriptions, and organize a company by the name, style and title of "The Indian Orchard and Lackawaxen turnpike road company," with power to construct a turnpike road, commencing at the Honesdale and Big Eddy turnpike road, at or near the depot of the New York and Erie railroad company, on the south side of the Lackawaxen river, at or near its junction with the river Delaware, passing through the contemplated village at the mouth of the Middle creek, and thence by the river Lackawaxen, or Delaware and Hudson canals, as near as practicable, to the termination above mentioned, subject to all the provisions and restrictions of an act regulating turnpike and plank road companies, approved the twenty-sixth day of January, one thousand eight hundred and forty-nine. ^{Style.} ^{Location.} ^{Subject to all the provisions and restrictions of a certain act.}

SECTION 2. That the capital stock of said company shall consist of one thousand shares, at twenty-five dollars each. ^{Capital stock.}

SECTION 3. That if said company shall not commence the construction of this road within two years, and complete the same within five years, this act shall be null and void, except so far as the same may be necessary to wind up its affairs, and pay the debts of said company. ^{Commencement and completion of road.}
