AN ACT

To incorporate the Tunkhannock Creek turnpike road company.

- SECTION 1.** *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That
- Commissioners.** Sherman D. Phelps, Samuel Starke, second, Andrew Gordiner, Nathaniel Bacon, Webster Ousterhout, Daniel H. Wade and Asa Howan, of the counties of Wyoming and Susquehanna, or a majority of them,
- Style.** be and they are hereby appointed commissioners to open books, receive subscriptions, and organize a company by the name, style and title of
- Location.** “The Tunkhannock Creek turnpike road company,” with power to construct a turnpike road from the borough of Tunkhannock, in Wyoming county, and thence by the best route up the Tunkhannock creek, passing near Bacon’s, Grow and Brothers and D. H. Wades’, to the Jackson and Harmony turnpike road, in Susquehanna county, the route of the road to be agreed upon and adopted by the stockholders, or a majority of them, at a meeting called for that purpose, subject to all the provisions and restrictions of an act regulating turnpike and plank road companies, approved the twenty-sixth day of January, one thousand eight hundred and forty-nine.
- Subject to all the provisions and restrictions of a certain act.**
- Capital stock.** **SECTION 2.** That the capital stock of said company, shall consist of
- Proviso.** thousand shares, at twenty-five dollars per share: *Provided,* That said company may from time to time, by a vote of the stockholders, at a meeting called for that purpose, increase their capital stock so much as may be necessary in their opinion to carry out the true intent and meaning of this act.
- Commencement and completion of road.** **SECTION 3.** That if said company shall not commence the construction of their road within two years after the passage of this act, and complete the same within five years thereafter, this act shall be null and void, except so far as the same may be necessary to wind up the affairs, and pay the debts of said company.
