A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT

To the act, entitled "An Act authorizing the governor to incorporate the Shippensville and Emlenton turnpike road company," approved the tenth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and thirty.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the charter for the Shippensville and Emlenton turnpike road, passed the tenth day of March, one thousand eight hundred and thirty, be and is hereby extended to March first, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-four, and that W. E. Bishop, William Perry, George A. Meeker and George Kribbs be and are hereby appointed commissioners, to act in connection with the surviving commissioners named in the act to which this is a supplement.

SECTION 2. That the provisions of the several sections of the act to which this is a supplement, be and are hereby extended to this act; and that so much of the act, entitled "An Act regulating turnpike and plank road companies," approved the twenty-sixth day of January, one thousand eight hundred and forty-nine, as is not inconsistent with the provisions of the act to which this is a supplement, be also extended to this act.
