AN ACT

For the relief of William Keeler.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the auditor general be and is hereby authorized and required to carefully examine the claim of William Keeler, of Bradford county, for work and labor done, and moneys expended on section twenty-four, lock number six, and aqueduct number one, Tioga line, North Branch extension of the Pennsylvania canal, and make a report thereof to the legislature.*

AN ACT

To extend the charter of the Bank of Montgomery County.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the charter of the Bank of Montgomery County shall be and the same is hereby extended and continued for the purpose of transacting the business of banking at its present location, for the term of fifteen years, from the expiration of the present charter, with the capital stock as at present fixed by law, subject to the provisions imposed by this act, and to the provisions now imposed upon the said bank, by existing laws of this commonwealth, and to such further provisions as the legislature*
