A FURTHER SUPPLEMENT

To the act relative to the Pennsylvania State lunatic hospital, passed April fourteenth, one thousand eight hundred and forty-five.

Preamble.

WHEREAS, By an act passed March four, one thousand eight hundred and forty-one, entitled "An Act to establish an asylum for the insane of this commonwealth," certain persons were appointed and commissioned by the governor to select and purchase a site for said asylum, and to contract and superintend the building thereof:

And whereas, In pursuance of said act, a tract of land on the west side of the river Schuylkill, in the county of Philadelphia, was purchased as a site for said asylum, which tract is now the property of the commonwealth, and no person appears to be legally authorized to have the care thereof; therefore,

Care, superintendence and management of the land purchased as a site for an asylum for the insane poor, conferred upon the commissioners named in a certain act.

Commissioners authorized to sell and convey.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the care, superintendence and management of the land purchased as a site for an asylum for the insane of this commonwealth, in pursuance of an act passed March fourth, one thousand eight hundred and forty-one, and the preservation of the property thereunto belonging, is hereby conferred upon the commissioners named in the act of April fourteenth, one thousand eight hundred and forty-five, entitled "An Act to establish an asylum for the insane poor of this commonwealth," and the supplement thereto, passed April eleventh, one thousand eight hundred and forty-eight; and the said commissioners are hereby authorized and empowered to sell at public sale, and convey the said tract and appurtenances to a purchaser or purchasers, whenever in their opinion a sale of the same can be effected on terms advantageous to the interests of the commonwealth; the proceeds of said sale to be paid into the state treasury.

A N A C T

For the relief of Bogle, Hall and Bogle, late contractors on the North Branch canal; and relating to the Mutual insurance company of Warren county; and relative to Allegheny cemetery.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the auditor general be and is hereby authorized and required to examine the claim of Bogle, Hall and Bogle, contractors on section number sixty-five, Tunkhannock division, North Branch canal, and make report thereof to the present or next legislature. Auditor general authorized to examine and adjust the claim of Bogle, Hall and Bogle, contractors.

SECTION 2. That any three of the corporators of the Warren county mutual insurance company, may give notice by publication in a newspaper in the borough of Warren, that an election for officers of said company will be held on the first Monday of May next, who shall hold their offices for the term of one year, and until their successors shall have been duly elected. Election of officers of Warren county mutual insurance company.

SECTION 3. That the managers of the Allegheny cemetery, in Allegheny county, shall have full power and authority to contract for, buy and acquire title in fee simple or otherwise, for a lot or lots of ground in the city of Pittsburg, for the purpose of constructing a receiving vault for the dead of all denominations; and also connected therewith, a building for funeral service, if in the judgment of the managers of the said corporation, the same shall be proper and necessary. Allegheny cemetery, in Allegheny county, managers authorized to contract for and acquire lot or lots of ground, &c.

SECTION 4. That the said managers shall also have power and authority to contract for, buy and acquire title in fee simple or otherwise, for an additional number of acres of ground contiguous to the ground at present enclosed by the cemetery, not exceeding one hundred acres, subject to the restrictions and immunities in the charter of the said corporation: *Provided,* That the same shall be used only for burial of the Further powers. Proviso.
