A SUPPLEMENT

To an act, entitled "An Act authorizing the governor to incorporate the Williams Valley railroad and mining company, in Dauphin and Schuylkill counties," passed the twenty-fifth day of May, Anno Domini, one thousand eight hundred and thirty-nine.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the president and directors of the Williams Valley railroad and mining company, shall be authorized to borrow on loan any sum, not exceeding fifteen thousand dollars, for the purpose of constructing railroads; and to secure the payment of the same, the president of said company, by a resolution of the board, approved by the stockholders holding a majority of the stock, shall execute and deliver to the person or persons who may loan to said company, a mortgage upon the lands of said company, securing to said persons their debts and interest, agreeably to the time stipulated between the parties.

Authorized to borrow money.
May mortgage their lands.

SECTION 2. That the president and directors of the said company shall have power to levy and assess, from time to time, under the authority of the stockholders as aforesaid, upon the several shares of stock of the said company in the hands of the owner or owners of the same, such sum or sums of money, not exceeding one dollar per share per annum, as may be necessary to pay debts, taxes, and defray the expenses of said company; and in case any of the person or persons holding stock in said company, shall neglect or refuse to pay any such sum or sums as may be assessed by the board of directors upon their several shares of stock, after sixty days' notice of such assessment, published in two newspapers, one in the city of Philadelphia, and one in the borough of Harrisburg, the board shall have the right to forfeit such stock to the company, and to offer the same again for sale if they should think proper: *Provided,* That if any person or persons holding any of the stock of the aforesaid company which may have been forfeited, shall come forward, within six months after the forfeiture, and

pay to the treasurer of the said company the amount of the assessment which had been levied on his or her stock, and for which the same had been forfeited, together with one per cent. per month interest on the same, the said stock shall be forthwith re-transferred to such owner or owners upon the books of the said company : *And provided further,* That all stockholders who have heretofore made advances for said company, shall be entitled to a credit on the books of the company for the same, and shall be paid out of the moneys in the treasury of the said company.

When this act to go into effect.

SECTION 3. That this act shall not go into effect until the assent, in writing, of three-fourths of the stockholders in number and interest shall be obtained thereto.
