AN ACT

Fixing the time of making assessments in Centre county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That hereafter the assessments of all taxes shall be made in the month of April, of each and every year, in the county of Centre; the said assessments to be made in accordance with the present law, in all respects, excepting the time as herein provided.*
