AN ACT

To exempt from taxation, (except for state and road purposes,) the house for the employment and support of the poor in the county of Schuylkill, and for other purposes.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That the employment of the house for the employment and support of the poor in the buildings and grounds of the house for the employment and support of the poor in Schuylkill county, and all personal property belonging to the same, hereby is and shall be exempt from taxation, except for state and road purposes. Building, &c., of the house for the employment of the poor in Schuylkill county, exempt from taxation.

SECTION 2. That the sixth section of an act, entitled "An Act to establish a uniform line along the river Delaware, and for other purposes," approved the eleventh day of April, one thousand eight hundred and forty-eight, repealing the second section of the act of assembly, passed the twenty-fifth January, Anno Domini one thousand eight hundred and thirty-six, relating to fees of constables in Schuylkill county, for executing orders for the relief or removal of paupers, be and the same is hereby repealed. Repeal of sixth section of certain act.
