AN ACT

For the relief of Adolphus Patterson; and a supplement to the act incorporating the Dauphin and Susquehanna coal company.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That* the canal commissioners be and are hereby authorized and instructed to examine the claim of Adolphus Patterson, of Blair county, for damages sustained by him by the sinking of his canal boat, on the Juniata division of the Pennsylvania canal, on the morning of the eleventh day of November, one thousand eight hundred and forty-eight, owing, as is alleged, to the carelessness or negligence of a lock-keeper or assistant lock-keeper, and report the facts to the legislature.

SECTION 2. That the provisions contained in an act, entitled "An Act regulating railroad companies," approved the nineteenth day of February, one thousand eight hundred and forty-nine, as far as they relate to the entering upon land and the payment of damages, shall apply to the Dauphin and Susquehanna coal company, in the construction of the railroad which said company is authorized to make.
