AN ACT

To change the times of holding the several courts of Mercer county.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That* from and after the passage of this act of Assembly, the several courts of the county of Mercer shall hold their terms, as follow, to wit: On the first Monday of May, the fourth Monday of August, the fourth Monday of November, and the third Monday of February, of this and each succeeding year, and each of the terms of said courts shall continue, if necessary, one week; and the judges of the Common Pleas and of the Orphans' Court of said county shall hold adjourned courts for the trial of causes and the transaction of any business within their jurisdiction as often as the business of said county may require, and all writs, rules, recognizances, orders, and decrees, made returnable in said courts, to the terms as now fixed by law, shall be considered as extended, continued, and returnable to the terms as fixed by this act.

AN ACT

For the relief of John McCord.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That* the State Treasurer be, and he is hereby authorized to pay to John McCord, of Bradford county, the sum of one thousand five hundred dollars out of any moneys in the treasury not otherwise appropriated, in full of certain damages sustained by him in consequence of the suspension of work on the North Branch canal, in the year one thousand eight hundred and forty-one.
