AN ACT

Relative to the sureties of Edmund L. Dana, Administrator of Ralph Peters, deceased.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That from and after the first day of March next, Mary Ellis, widow and executrix of Henry D. Ellis, late of Lycoming county, deceased, be and she is hereby released from all liability accruing thereafter, for or by reason of a bond executed by the said Henry D. Ellis, in his life time, as security for Edmund L. Dana, administrator of Ralph Peters, deceased, in accordance with an act of the General Assembly, approved the thirteenth day of April, Anno Domini, one thousand eight hundred and forty-three, entitled "An Act authorizing the executors of Putnam Catlin, late of the county of Susquehanna, deceased, to sell and convey certain real estate, and for other purposes:"* *Provided, That the said Edmund L. Dana shall not be authorized, after the first day of March next, to make any sales of the real estate of said Ralph Peters, deceased, until he shall have entered into a new bond with sureties, to be approved as required by the act as aforesaid.*

AN ACT

Authorizing the Directors of the Farmers' and Mechanics' Bank of Easton to make sale of stock.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That the directors of the Farmers' and Mechanics' Bank of Easton be, and they are hereby authorized to make sale of the residue of the shares of the stock of said bank not subscribed for, at such times and places*
