To authorize John A. Snyder, late Treasurer of the county of Somerset, to appeal from the report of the county auditors, for the year ending sixth of January, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-one.

WHEREAS, It is alleged by John A. Snyder, late treasurer of the county of Somerset, that an error was made in the settlement of his accounts by the auditors, of the said county of Somerset, at the settlement which was made in the month of January, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-one, which was not discovered until the succeeding settlement, which took place in the month of January, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-two; therefore,

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same,* That John A. Snyder, late treasurer of the county of Somerset, be, and he is hereby authorized and empowered to appeal from the report of the settlement of his accounts, as filed by the auditors of the county of Somerset, in the office of the prothonotary of the said county, for the year ending sixth January, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-one, in the same manner and with the same effect as if the appeal had been taken and entered in the office of the said prothonotary, within the time prescribed by existing laws: *Provided,* That the appeal hereby authorized, be taken within three months from the passage of this act.
