A N A C T

Extending the first, second, third and fourth sections of an act entitled "An act Taxing Dogs in Chester county, and for other purposes" to the Counties of Clarion, Armstrong and Jefferson.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same*, That from and after the passage of this act the first, second, third and fourth sections of an act, entitled "An act laying a tax on dogs in certain townships, in the county of Chester, relative to elections in West Philadelphia, and to assessors in Milledown, Perry county," be and the same is hereby extended to the counties of Clarion, Armstrong and Jefferson: *Provided however*, That the tax on one dog shall only be fifty cents and any additional dog one dollar, and two dollars for each and every bitch so assessed.
