Regulating the salary of the Marshal and Lieutenants of Police, of the city of Philadelphia.

SECTION 1. *Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania in General Assembly met, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That from and after the first day of August, one thousand eight hundred and fifty-four, the marshal of police, of the city of Philadelphia, shall receive an annual stipend or salary of two thousand and five hundred dollars, to be paid in quarterly payments, out of the treasury of said city; and any existing law or laws as is hereby altered or supplied, shall be and the same is hereby repealed; and that the lieutenants of the marshal's police, shall receive a salary at the rate of eight hundred and fifty dollars per annum, which salaries of said marshal and lieutenants shall be calculated from the commencement of the present year.*
