AN ACT

Making an appropriation to the West Side Hospital Association of Scranton.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That the sum of fifteen thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby specifically appropriated to the West Side Hospital Association of Scranton, for the two fiscal years beginning June first, one thousand nine hundred and one, for the following purposes, namely:

For the purpose of maintenance, the sum of ten thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary.

For the erection, completion, equipment and furnishing of a new building, the sum of five thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary.

July 18, 1901.—This bill is approved except as to the item appropriating \$5,000 for the erection, completion, equipment and furnishing of a new building, from which I withhold my approval because of insufficient State revenue.

AN ACT

Making an appropriation to the medical and surgical department of the Western Pennsylvania Hospital at Pittsburg.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That the sum of one hundred thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby specifically appropriated to the medical and surgical department of the Western Pennsylvania Hospital at Pittsburg, for the two fiscal years beginning June first, one thousand nine hundred and one, for the following purposes, namely:

For the purpose of maintenance, the sum of ninety thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary.

For the purpose of repairs to hospital buildings, the sum of ten thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary: Provided, That in consideration of this appropriation, there shall be fifteen free beds maintained, which shall be filled upon the certificate of the mayor, director of the department of public safety, or
