AN ACT

Making an appropriation to the Hospital Department of the Hahnemann Medical College and Hospital, of Philadelphia.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That the sum of fifty thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby specifically appropriated to Hospital Department of the Hahnemann Medical College and Hospital, of Philadelphia, for the two fiscal years beginning June first, one thousand nine hundred and one, for the purpose of maintenance. Approved for \$45,000.
