AN ACT

Making an appropriation to the Chester County Hospital.

Approved for
\$12,000.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That the sum of fourteen thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby specifically appropriated to the Chester County Hospital, situate in the borough of West Chester, Chester county, for the two fiscal years beginning June first, one thousand nine hundred and one, for the purpose of maintenance.

July 18, 1901.—This bill is approved in the sum of \$12,000, and I withhold my approval from the balance of said appropriation because of insufficient State revenue.

AN ACT

Making an appropriation to the Charity Hospital of Norristown.

Appropriation.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That the sum of twenty-three thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary, be and the same is hereby specifically appropriated to the Charity Hospital of Norristown, for the two fiscal years beginning June first, one thousand nine hundred and one, for the following purposes, namely:

Maintenance.
This item approved for \$10,000.

For the purpose of maintenance, the sum of fifteen thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary.

This item disapproved.

For the purpose of the purchase of additional ground and for the erection of a laundry and nurses home, the sum of eight thousand dollars, or so much thereof as may be necessary.

July 18, 1901.—This bill is approved except as to the following items:—

I approve of the item appropriating \$15,000 for maintenance in the sum of \$10,000, and withhold my approval from the balance of said item.

I withhold my approval of the item appropriating \$8,000 for the purchase of additional ground for laundry and nurses home.

I have made the aforesaid reductions because of insufficient State revenue.
