propriation shall be made on order of the chairman of said commission by warrant of the Auditor General on the State Treasurer.

## AN ACT

To repeal an act, approved the eighteenth day of July, one thousand nine hundred nineteen (Pamphlet Laws, one thousand fifty-five), "An act in relation to the public safety, defense, and welfare of the Commonwealth and of the United States; continuing the Commission of Public Safety and Defense as a Commission of Public Welfare; prescribing its powers and duties; and making an appropriation."

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That the act, approved the eighteenth day of July, one thousand nine hundred nineteen (Pamphlet Laws, one thousand fifty five), enand welfare of the Commonwealth and of the United repealed.
