

LAWS OF PENNSYLVANIA,

APPROPRIATION.

Section 10. In order to defray all necessary expenses, including printing, engraving, and advertising connected with the issuance of bonds authorized by the provisions of this act, the sum of fifty thousand dollars (\$50,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby specifically appropriated.

Payments from said appropriation shall be made, on order of the Governor, by warrant of the Auditor General on the State Treasurer.

AN ACT

Making an appropriation to the Lake Erie and Ohio River Canal Board of Pennsylvania for the payment of expenses incurred in printing, distributing, and making available for public use reports, maps, documents, and records of the board; in securing the co-operation and aid of the Government of the United States and other public authorities in the construction of the canal or waterway authorized to be constructed by the board; for the payment of incidental office expense; and for the payment of salaries, fees, and expenses.

Appropriation.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That there is hereby specifically appropriated to the use of the Lake Erie and Ohio River Canal Board of Pennsylvania the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000), or so much thereof as may be necessary, for the payment of expenses incurred in printing, distributing, or in otherwise making available for public use reports, maps, documents, and records issued by or in possession of the board; for the payment of expenses incurred in doing such things as the board may deem expedient to secure the co-operation and aid of the Government of the United States and other public authorities in the construction of the canal or waterway authorized to be constructed by the said act; and for the payment of expenses incidental to the maintenance of the offices of the board in the city of Pittsburgh, the traveling expenses of the board, and any of its officers or employes, and the payment of the salaries, fees, and expenses of such engineers, draftsmen, attorneys, experts, and clerical assistance as the board may employ.
