

All other acts or parts of acts of Assembly supplied by, inconsistent with, or appertaining to the subject matter covered by this act, are hereby repealed. It is the intention that this act shall furnish a complete and exclusive system for the government and regulation of boroughs, except as to the several matters enumerated in section one hundred and two of article one of this act.

Other inconsistent acts.

Act an exclusive system.

But nothing contained in this act shall be construed to repeal any local or special laws; or to repeal the provisions of the Public Service Company Law, or any law relating to the Board of Commissioners of Navigation for the River Delaware and its Navigable Tributaries, or the provisions of any law the enforcement of which is vested in the Department of Health or the Sanitary Water Board, or the provisions of any law the enforcement of which is vested in the Department of Forests and Waters or the Water and Power Resources Board.

Exceptions.

AN ACT

Relating to purchases by boroughs.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That the borough authorities shall not be required to prepare specifications and advertise for the purchase of articles or parts thereof which are patented and manufactured products, apparatus, or appliances, nor in all such cases shall they be required to exact a bond: Provided, This act shall not apply to materials used in street improvements.
