## AN ACT

To repeal the act, approved the twelfth day of June, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (Pamphlet Laws, one hundred and eighty-seven), entitled "An act to ascertain and appoint the fees to be received by the sheriffs, coroners, prothonotaries, clerks of the several courts, registers of wills, and recorders of deeds of this Commonwealth, except in counties containing more than one hundred and fifty thousand or less than ten thousand inhabitants."

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That the act, approved the twelfth day of June, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-eight (Pamphlet Laws, one hundred and eighty-seven), entitled "An act to ascertain and appoint the fees to be received by the sheriffs, coroners, prothonotaries, clerks of the several courts, registers of wills, and recorders of deeds, of this Commonwealth, except in counties containing more than one hundred and fifty thousand or less than ten thousand inhabitants," be and the same is hereby repealed.

## AN ACT

To repeal the act, approved the first day of May, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-nine (Pamphlet Laws, forty-four), entitled "A supplement to an act, entitled 'An act creating and defining the duties and powers of a recorder for the cities, whose population does not exceed thirty thousand and is not less than eight thousand five hundred, which accept the provisions of this act,' approved March twenty-fourth, one thousand eight hundred and seventy-seven; amending said act."

Section 1.
