

Shenango and Beaver Rivers; conferring and continuing certain powers and duties on the Department of Forests and Waters in relation to the establishment and maintenance of such reservoir; providing for the acquisition of necessary lands therefor, and the necessary agreements and releases relating thereto, and the disposition of surplus land and materials,' authorizing the construction of a dam and spillway at the outlet of Pymatuning Swamp on lands acquired therefor, and making an appropriation to the Department of Forests and Waters," be and it is hereby amended to read as follows:

Pymatuning reservoir.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That the sum of one million five hundred thousand dollars (\$1,500,000), or as much thereof as may be necessary, is hereby specifically appropriated to the Department of Forests and Waters, for the use of the Water and Power Resources Board, for the construction of a dam and spillway across the outlet of Pymatuning Swamp, in Crawford County, on lands heretofore acquired therefor, *for clearing the reservoir site, for raising, relocating, and reconstructing railroads and highways which the Water and Power Resources Board shall deem necessary in connection with the reservoir project, for acquiring additional lands necessary for the completion of the reservoir and the relocation of railroads and highways, and for any other expenses of every kind and description which the Water and Power Resources Board shall deem necessary in connection with the completion of the Pymatuning reservoir project.*

Section 2. This act shall become effective immediately upon its approval by the Governor.

AN ACT

To amend a certain appropriation item contained in section one of the act, approved the thirteenth day of June, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one (Act No. Eighteen-A), entitled "An act making an appropriation to the Department of Property and Supplies for the acquisition of land and buildings for the Commonwealth, and the erection and construction of new buildings and additions, alterations or improvements to and replacement of new or existing buildings of the Commonwealth, including fixtures and heating or sewerage systems and service lines for the accommodation of buildings."

Appropriation for lands and buildings.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That the item making an appropriation to the Department of Property and

Supplies for the construction, additions and alterations of buildings for the Torrance State Hospital, at Torrance, Pennsylvania, contained in section one of the act, approved the thirteenth day of June, one thousand nine hundred thirty one (Act Number Eighteen-A), under the heading "Hospitals for the Insane," be and the same is hereby amended to read as follows:

For the erection and construction of new buildings and for additions and alterations to or replacement of existing buildings, *for the construction of a dam and for the acquisition of the lands necessary for the construction of the dam*, for the Torrance State Hospital, at Torrance, Pennsylvania, the sum of five hundred fifty thousand dollars (\$515,000).

A SUPPLEMENT

To the act, approved the eleventh day of June, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one (Act Number Fifteen-A), entitled "An act to provide for the ordinary expenses of the Executive, Legislative, and Judicial Departments of the Commonwealth, interest on the public debt, and the support of the public schools, for two years beginning June first, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-one; and for the payment of bills incurred and remaining unpaid at the close of the fiscal year ending May thirty-first, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-one," making additional appropriations to the Department of Military Affairs and to the Department of Welfare.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That in addition to the appropriation made by the act, approved the eleventh day of June, one thousand nine hundred thirty-one, known as "The General Appropriation Act of one thousand nine hundred thirty-one" (Act Number Fifteen-A), to the Department of Military Affairs for the use of the State Veterans Commission, an additional sum of one hundred thousand dollars (\$100,000) is hereby appropriated to the Department of Military Affairs for the use of the State Veterans Commission in furnishing funds to provide the necessities of life for and to assist otherwise such Pennsylvania veterans of any war, or the widows and infant children or dependents of such veterans, as are sick, disabled, indigent or unemployed and who are in need and have no relatives or other persons legally liable and able to support them.
