Section 3. The expenses incurred by the Insurance Expenses of audit. Department in making any examination and audit under the provisions of this act shall be ascertained by the department, and shall be certified to the State Workmen's Insurance Board, whereupon the board shall draw its warrant for the payment thereof to the department out of the State Workmen's Insurance Fund. amount so received by the Insurance Department shall be paid by it into the General Fund, through the Department of Revenue. The moneys in the State Work-men's Insurance Fund are hereby appropriated for pay-of moneys. ment of expenses of audits and examinations made under

this act. Section 4. This act shall become effective on the first Effective date. day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirtythree.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That the laws relating to townships of the second class are hereby amended, consolidated, revised, and changed as follows:

ARTICLE I

PRELIMINARY PROVISIONS

The Second Class Township Law. Section 101. Short Title.—This act shall be known, and may be cited, as "The Second Class Township Law." This act shall take effect on the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-three.
