AN ACT

To amend section two of the act, approved the first day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-one (Pamphlet Laws, two hundred and ninety-nine), entitled "An act requiring retail dealers in liquid fuels to state the rate of the liquid fuels tax, separately from the price of such liquid fuels, on liquid fuel price display signs; and imposing a penalty," and providing for disposition of fine.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That section two of the Liquid fuels. act, approved the first day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-one (Pamphlet Laws, two hundred ninety-nine), entitled "An act requiring retail dealers in liquid fuels to state the rate of the liquid fuels tax, separately from the price of such liquid fuels, on liquid fuel price display signs; and imposing a penalty," is

hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. Any person, partnership, association or corporation violating any of the provisions of section one of this act shall, upon conviction in a summary proceeding, be sentenced to pay a fine of twenty-five dollars Penalty. (\$25.00), and costs of prosecution, and, in default of payment thereof, such person or the partners of such partnership or the officers of such association or corporation shall undergo imprisonment for not more than ten days. All fines, that shall be received, paid or collected under the provisions of this act, shall be paid into the State Treasury, through the Department of Revenue, and credited to Motor License Fund.

AN ACT

To abolish the December assessment and registration of voters, and repealing inconsistent legislation.

Be it enacted, &c., That the annual assessment and registration of voters in the election districts of this Commonwealth commencing on the first Monday December in December, and ending on the sixty-first day before the third Tuesday in February, be, and the same is hereby, abolished and superseded; and that all the duties with respect to such December assessment and registration, or in any way appertaining or applicable thereto, heretofore required of and from the assessors in the various election districts, be, and the same are hereby, abrogated and anulled.
