## AN ACT

To amend section three of article five, and section three of article six, of an act, approved the twenty-fifth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and nineteen (Pamphlet Laws, five hundred and eighty-one), entitled "An act for the better government of cities of the first class of this Commonwealth," by transferring the care, management, administration, and supervision of electrical lighting from the department of public safety to the department of public works.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That section three of article five of the act, approved the twenty-fifth day of June, one thousand nine hundred and nineteen (Pamphlet Laws, five hundred and eighty-one), entitled "An act for the better government of cities of the first class of this Commonwealth," is hereby amended to read as follows:

Cities of first class.

Section 3, Article V, act of June 25, 1919 (P. L. 581), amended.

Section 3. The department of public safety shall have the care, management, administration, and supervision of the police affairs and all matters relating to the fire and police forces, electrical service (*except electrical lighting*), erection of fire-escapes, and the inspection of buildings, elevators, engines, and boilers.

Electrical lighting removed from department of public safety.

Section 2. That section three of article six of said act is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 3, Article VI, amended.

Section 3. The department of public works shall have the care, management, administration, and supervision of waterworks, gas-works, and other public utilities (except as otherwise provided in this act) owned or controlled by the city, the supply and distribution of water and gas, the grading, paving, repairing, cleaning, and lighting [ (except electric lighting) ] of streets, alleys, and highways, including footways, the construction, protection, maintenance, operation, and repair of public buildings, bridges, and structures of every kind for public use, public squares, real estate (except as otherwise provided by this act or as is now or may hereafter be provided by law or ordinance), surveys, engineering, sewerage, drainage, and all matters and things in any way relating to or affecting the highways or footways of the city.

Electrical lighting placed in department of public works.
