To amend clause fifty-eight of section one thousand two hundred and two of the act, approved the fourth day of May, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-seven (Pamphlet Laws, five hundred nineteen), entitled "An act concerning boroughs; and revising, amending, and consolidating the law relating to boroughs," authorizing boroughs to acquire, maintain, and operate bus feeder lines in connection with inclined plane passenger and vehicular traffic transportation facilities.

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That clause nity-cight of section one thousand two hundred and two of the act, approved the fourth day of May, one thousand nine hundred dred and twenty-seven (Pamphlet Laws, five hundred nineteen), entitled "An act concerning boroughs; and march 20, 1935 (Act No. 4). to boroughs," as added by the act approved the twentieth day of March, one thousand nine hundred and thirtyfive (Act Number four), is hereby amended to read as follows:

LVIII. Inclined Planes.—To acquire by purchase, Inclined planes. lease, or otherwise, from a public service company, any existing inclined plane passenger and vehicular traffic transportation facilities, and to maintain and operate the same in the transportation of passengers and vehicles for hire, and for the accommodation of the public, and in like manner to acquire or to establish bus feeder Bus feeder lines. lines, and to maintain and operate the same in connection with such inclined plane passenger and vehicular traffic transportation facilities.

Section 2. The provisions of this act shall become ef- When effective. fective immediately upon its final enactment.
