derived in any way from or on account of the State forests, State parks, recreational areas, and other lands Moneys payable to State Forests and Waters and waters under the jurisdiction of the Department of Forests and Waters, together with all water powers and Fund. water rights belonging to this Commonwealth in the streams, rivers, lakes, or other waters of this Commonwealth under the jurisdiction of the Department of Forests and Waters, and all receipts and proceeds resulting from the collection of the costs of forest fire extinction, and all other activities of the Department of Forests and Waters, shall be credited to the State Forests and Waters Fund.

Section 2. This act shall become effective on the first When effective. day of June, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-five.

AN ACT

To amend section two of the act, approved the twenty-seventh day of April, one thousand nine hundred and twenty-seven (Pam-phlet Laws, four hundred nine), entitled "An act authorizing the Secretary of Highways to join two or more State highway routes, by the construction of connecting roads, under certain conditions, and providing for the payment of damages for land taken in the construction of such connecting roads.'

Section 1. Be it enacted, &c., That section two of the Highways. act, approved the twenty-seventh day of April, one thouact, approved the twenty-seventh day of April, one thou-sand nine hundred and twenty-seven (Pamphlet Laws, of April 27, 1927 four hundred nine) entitled ((An act outbourising the (P. L. 409)) four hundred nine), entitled "An act authorizing the amended. Secretary of Highways to join two or more State highway routes, by the construction of connecting roads, under certain conditions, and providing for the payment of damages for land taken in the construction of such connecting roads," is hereby amended to read as follows:

Section 2. Any connecting road, built under the provisions of this act, shall be constructed and maintained as a State highway, and any damage occasioned by the taking of land for the construction of such connecting road shall be determined and paid in the same manner as [is now] provided by law in the construction of State highways.

The provisions of this act shall become when effective. Section 2. effective immediately upon its final enactment.
