By virtue of the authority vested in me by Article IV, Section 12, of the Constitution, I, George H. Earle, Governor of Pennsylvania, do hereby convene the General Assembly of the Commonwealth in extraordinary session, to meet in the Capitol, at Harrisburg, on Tuesday, December 1, one thousand nine hundred thirty-six, at twelve o'clock, noon, of that day, to consider legislation upon the following subjects:

1. Unemployment insurance and appropriations incidental thereto.
2. Appropriations for the expenses of the Special Session.
