AN ACT

Transferring money received from the sale of certain real estate and paid into the General Fund, from the General Fund to the Motor License Fund.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The State Treasurer is hereby authorized and directed to transfer the sum of five thousand dollars (\$5,000) received from the sale of real estate described in and authorized by the act, approved the eighteenth day of April, one thousand nine hundred forty-one (Pamphlet Laws, twenty), entitled "An act authorizing the Department of Property and Supplies, with the approval of the Governor, to sell and convey two certain plots of land," and paid as provided by said act, into the General Fund of the State Treasury from the said General Fund to the Motor License Fund. Such transfer shall be made immediately after the effective date of this act, upon the warrant of the Auditor General, upon requisition of the Governor.

The purpose of this transfer is to return to the Motor License Fund the funds paid therefrom for the purchase of the real estate, conveyed under the provisions of said act, approved the eighteenth day of April, one thousand nine hundred forty-one (Pamphlet Laws, twenty).

AN ACT

Providing that the proceeds of the sale of real estate owned by the Commonwealth, together with the rentals derived therefrom, shall be repaid to and credited to the proper special fund from which the funds to purchase said real estate were taken.

The General Assembly of the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania hereby enacts as follows:

Section 1. The proceeds of the sale of any real estate owned by the Commonwealth when sold by any department, board or commission thereof, with the specific authority of the General Assembly as provided by existing law, together with any rentals derived therefrom while the same shall have been owned by the Commonwealth, shall be paid into the General Fund of
